

MINUTES BOARD MEETING March 27, 2022

The minutes from the January meeting were previously emailed to all members.

INTRODUCTORY BUSINESS:

- Mary Willis is our Bass Nation of VA contact point for reservations at the Clarion Point (formerly Magnuson) and Quality Inn (formerly the Lake Motel). Mary provided a quick tour to the members. The rooms are nice and very fisherman friendly.
- Mike Bryant briefly read the qualifications of Susan Owens for the secretary/treasurer position. The board voted yes unanimously effective immediately.

OLD BUSINESS:

- <u>2022 State Team</u> Jerseys have been ordered. Team members have been registered.
- Bylaw Changes Updated and uploaded to the website.
- 2022 Mr. BASS Postponed due to weather conditions Mike appointed Craig Owens as tournament committee chairman. Due to unavailability of ramps to reschedule, a motion by Bruce Shepherd, Region 10, seconded by Steve Woodruff, Vice-President to cancel Mr. Bass increasing the State Fish Off berths from 25 to 35 boats for each of the 6-Man and Fall Classic tournaments. Any same partner teams fishing both 6-Man and Fall Classic will receive a berth in the State Fish Off. Vote results: Region 3 abstained, all other members voted yes. Anyone who entered the Mr. Bass tournament may ask for a refund or ask for their Mr. Bass entry to roll over to the 6 Man or Fall Classic events.

BASS announced the National Championship on Pickwick Lake has been changed to November 9-11. Our State Fish off is November 12-13. A one-time, non-precedential agreement by the members to offer our 2 members fishing the Nationals a berth in the State Fish Off as long as they fish at least 1 of the 6-Man

or Fall Classic. All agreed. Permanency of this offer to be voted on for bylaw change at the January 2023 meeting.

Members agreed to get tournament dates set earlier. Susan will provide a call-in number for a special meeting on Monday, May 23rd at 7:30pm to set 2023 adult tournament dates. Youth tournament dates to be approved thereafter.

- 2022 JSQ3 N&S Postponed due to weather conditions Cancelled. No available dates for rescheduling. Craig Owens discussed the cancellation decision of both Mr. Bass and JSQ3 N&S events. The board members present made the decision.
- March 19 State College Team Championship The Virginia Tech team of Ryan Feehein and Spence Francis won with 22 lbs. and lunker. Liberty College came in 2nd. There were 8 teams competing. Posted on Facebook.
