New Business:

B.A.S.S. Discussion of President Meeting at B.A.S.S. National Championship -

Pickwick was very tough producing only 5 limits on day 1 and 6 limits on day 2.

Congratulations to Jeff and Eric for getting to Nationals.

New changes begin in 2024. Not set in stone yet. BASS still working out details.

- Each state will send teams straight to the Nationals. No more State Team competing in Regionals.
- BASS will announce in September the number of teams each state can send.
- That number will be percentage based ranked by membership across the states.
- We no longer pay an entry fee for the teams, but BASS will no longer provide hotel, fuel, or boat yard.
- Nationals will be a 250-boat pro-am with \$100,000 payout anticipating TV coverage.
- BASS says states can run their qualifying tournaments the way they choose; team or pro-am format.
- Virginia will need to decide at the January board meeting how we determine our teams for Nationals; whether we use team or pro-am format for our qualifiers (For example: if BASS says VA gets 6 teams. Do we take top B/NB from Mr. Bass, Chapter Team, and Fall Classic with top 3 B/NB from State Championship); and to what extent the state will contribute to expenses of the teams going to Nationals.

BASS is setting up new Nation Regionals in 2024 to replace their current OPENS. Not set in stone. BASS still working out details.

- Each state will be given a certain number of codes for early bird entry into the Regional like signing up for the ELITES. Thereafter, the Nation Regionals will be open to "at large" competitors who must pay state dues to their state.
- BASS will determine by membership percentage the number of codes to each state.
- 250 boat field. Boater entry \$500. Non-boater entry \$250. Pro-Am format.
- Virginia will need to decide at the January meeting how we determine who gets early bird codes and if the state will contribute to expenses of early birds or is it pay your own way.

Other general changes:

Clubs can consist of as few as 2 members National dues will probably increase from \$30 to \$50 BASS is planning to standardize state dues across the states.

Youth Director Jack Babcock motioned to add Board meeting to calendar on February 26. Seconded by R5 Pam Bryant. Motion passed unanimously. R7 Craig Owens motioned to add the College Team Championship to calendar for March 4th on Kerr Lake. Seconded by R2 Ray Tweedy. Motion passed unanimously. Jack Babcock noted there will be a College Open on James River April 21-22, 2023. Typographical date changes. Updated <u>Official Calendar</u> to be posted to website.
