2023 Bylaws Update

A redline version of amendments approved at the January meeting and incorporated together with the clean copy were emailed to all members prior to the board meeting. The clean copy was included in the board meeting package. Roll call vote of members present: 9 for, 1 against - R6 Chris Merritt motioned to amend Article 8 section 29 TIES to read "All ties occurring in the final point standings to be broken first by total weight not including dropped tournament, second by of total number of fish weighed in not including dropped tournament, and third by flip of a coin." Motion to amend seconded by R5 Mike Bryant. This motion to be taken back to regions and vote will be taken prior to first tournament. Sid noted that during last conference call with BASS, Hank Weldon stated the BNC is planned to be in October every year going forward.

2023 B.A.S.S. Nationals

The official dates for 2023 BNC have been changed to October 17-20. Our fourth tournament is Oct 21/22. Due to required participation at BNC by board members and VA's State Team winners, motion by TD J.T. Williams to move our 4th tournament to October 28/29. Seconded by R6 Chris Merritt. Roll Vote of members present: 9 for, 1 abstain. Passed.

Mr. Bass entry form was included in board meeting package and is posted on the website. Tournament meeting at Parkview HS gym discussed due to fees. Cici Carroll joining Mecklenburg County Chamber of Commerce and may get fees waived. All approved to reserve the Parkview HS gym whether or not fee is required for March 31st Mr. Bass

tournament meeting. Also discussed there is no requirement for copies of boat insurance. Random checks will occur at tournaments.

- Request to allow expense allowance to state team members not staying at team contracted hotel denied by board.

Conservation

BASS Aftco sponsor gives 10% of sales to conservation so purchase Aftco products. Grant cycle ends March 15. TN conservation is starting a riverfront "Adopt an Access". Melanie plans to begin with 2 times/year. Also Melanie notes there is spotted bass virus and asks to track if you see one by measurement on a ruler with picture.
